They were pleased with it and Ellen proposed that we hold a traditional walk there next fall, 2015 and then add it as a RR Year Round Event in January, 2016. Tales from the Trails: Alaska, Land of the Wonderful By: Herb Laing Recently, I had the opportunity to take a trip with the Wisconsin Dairyland Walkers. What a

Dairyland Walkers. What a wonderful experience. Our trip started in Fairbanks with a great walk around the city. Passing the Chena River, the scenery was exceptional.

From Fairbanks we traveled to Denali National Park where we had our second walk of the trip. This walk was a little more challenging as it included a few hills. On this walk, we had our first encounter with the local fauna. A cow moose, deciding that humans made the area safe, walked past our group to get a drink of water in the lake. While visiting Denali, we also saw black bears, golden eagles, caribou, and the ever present magpie. Leaving Denali, we bused to Anchorage for an evening walk around a lake and the city. Here we saw. loons and other water fowl and of course the Alaskan state bird, the mosquito.

The next morning we got up early to head toward Seward where we caught our ship for the cruise. Before boarding, we had the opportunity to walk through Seward and the Kenai national forest. Here we saw our first sea otters (most playful creatures) as well as the majestic Bald Eagle (one of which greeted us as we boarded the ship).

We cruised for a day before landing in Haines where we walked through this historic town. It had one of the last frontier forts in Alaska, following Haines, we traveled to Juneau where we hiked through the city, the hills were even steeper than in Denali. The state capital is unique and worth visiting. And don't pass up the opportunity to go whale watching and to visit Mendenhall Glacier. Leaving Juneau, we were off to Ketchikan, the wettest spot in the US. We had sunshine the whole day. This too is a very unique city to walk through, with its' historic buildings, waterfront, and bald eagles.
