#### Food for Thought

Something was mentioned at the January Roadrunner meeting: we never see any of the AVA headquarters staff at walks. This comment went totally off my radar but merits some comment since this topic has surfaced on and off for the last several years.

A few years ago the AVA president required that all the headquarters staff participate in at least one Volksmarch a year and to "feel the pain" of coordinating a year around event from start to finish. This was when Mitchell Lake became a year around event. When that president resigned, the walk requirement went away. The year around event stayed in place.

The AVA office staff are hired to work in the office. We all think it would be great if they all participated in Volkssport events. They can do this voluntarily on their own time. If they are required to participate they have to be paid. If a walk box has to be checked like at Mitchell Lake and it takes someone out of the AVA office, it's not in their job description and liability issues arise.

I would suggest as part of a new employee's orientation that they attend one traditional walk to observe how things are done and how their position fits into the big picture. They don't have to walk; just observe the process.
