Heller RUN RUN ... or should I say WALK WALK as fast as you can... yes, we saw "Sam" the gingerbread man – I am talking about this past years 10-11-12-13-14 program walk in Belleville, Illinois. I noticed in the American Wanderer that this may be the last year this walk would be conducted and it seemed rather intriguing. So I packed my bags and soon was off to the St. Louis area. A gingerbread cookie walk? OK. Walk 10km and collect cookies along the route. Oh, was I in for a treat; it was much, much more than that.

That morning, yes ... 12/13/14, I was excited to do a walk with another great group, The Illinois Trekkers Walking Club. I rolled out of bed with visions of sugar plums - I mean gingerbread, dancing in my head. I arrived into the Belleville Bank parking lot about a half hour early and was already met with a line out the door and around the building. Wow! So many here to walk or collect cookies? I soon found out that this is an experience, not just a walk, not just cookies, but an all-around great adventure.

I reached the double doors to the bank and received my brief on how this was all to go down. I had pre-registered, as was recommended and a good thing or noooo cookies for me. With walk instructions and brown cookie bag in hand, we (group from Missouri and I) headed off on the first five kilometers which was through quaint neighborhoods and the beautiful campus of Lindenwood University. We had a few cookie stops along that route; the majority was impending on the second half. It is obvious that I cannot even begin to tell all about this part, the last half of the 10km, which in fact was one of the longest 5kms I have ever walked. With over 530 walkers all trekking and accumulating cookies, it was a wonder that we ever finished the walk at all. I felt like a little girl waiting to open presents on Christmas morning. We tried to move as quickly as possible, but there was sooo much going on in the center of town. Stop number four was the Belleville City Hall, where we were serenaded with a fantastic barbershop quartet. They were really good! Almost forgot to collect my cookie, sure would have hated to have to go back, NOT! We saw Santa in the town square which was also where the Christkindlmarkt was. Many unique and interesting surprises were lurking along the avenue and in the alleyways. There wasn't any snow on the ground, but it still felt like Christmas with the horse drawn trolleys, Christmas scenes, lights, carolers, decorations posted on electric poles, Christmas trees and the sweet smells of nutmeg, ginger and cinnamon. Some of us even managed to win prizes at different venues and stores along the route. One of the most impressive sites as we were strolling was seeing the award winning gingerbread houses. Such talent these champs had. All were nicely displayed in the windows of businesses along the way.

In all, we each collected three dozen cookies, not just gingerbread, but numerous varieties and proceeded to collect our special stamp in our AVA books. What a fantastic and fun walk, experience, adventure or whatever you want to call it.

Friendly reminder from HQ Awards and Membership Coordinator:

Karen would like to ask clubs for their help. If you see walkers with 10, 30, and 50 event books, ask them if they understand how the AVA programs work. Show the walkers the back side of event books. The back of the books tell what color book is needed for Awards levels. Do not cut up insert cards and paste into event books. Handwritten entries are also not allowed. Most of the distance books are printed with 10k walks in mind. If walkers can only do 5k's, let them know to use insert cards to reach the 500k that is needed. Remind walkers that Karen cannot process insert cards without a book. If there are carryovers and the amount is more than the next level book, \$6 needs to be sent to Karen so she can supply a book to utilize the carryover.
