First in a Series Featuring Roadrunner Year Around Events:

Friedrich Wilderness Park Friedrich Wilderness Park, a 600 acre preserve at 21395 Milsa Drive on the west side of IH-10, across from the Dominion, became San Antonio's first natural area after landowner, Norma Friedrich Ward died September 11, 1971. Upon her death, Mrs. Ward gave the initial 180 acres for use as a public park. She wanted it to stay as natural as possible. Over the years, development has threatened to envelope this space. When financing for a resort that bordered the park fell through, that property became part of the park.

There are four levels of trail within the park with level 1 being the easiest with gentle slopes. The most difficult level has unimproved dirt trails with steep and vertical rock ledges.

The Roadrunners will feature this YRE on 4 February, 2017. Then you can see for yourself how the park is nestled in the middle of an exploding real estate market. Don't forget your walking stick.

Open Letter To RR Club Members From A Volunteer

As you sign up for a walk you may notice that it is always the same people working the registration, finish and checkpoints. This is not because we are part of some clique or an elite group or that we want control -- it is because we are volunteers who want more walks in the future and we know that if we don't do it there will be no walks. Volksmarching is run by unpaid volunteers and without them there would be no volksmarches.

At our last walk we had a shortage of workers and there was discussion that we should discontinue some of our walks in the future. Several clubs in our area have disbanded because of a lack of volunteers, including but not limited to Boerne, Wimberley, Medina, and Sam Ramblers, so this has cut down on the number of area walks. It would be a sad day if we cut back on our walks or even caused the club to disband.

Many walkers have walked for years and never volunteered to assist.

Working a shift at a walk once in a while would not take a lot of time or energy. Most shifts are only two hours and there is plenty of time to do the actual walk before or after your shift, or at a workers walk. Working a shift is a rewarding experience as you get to know other walkers. I know that because of my volunteering I have made lifelong friends.

Think about this and help us keep volksmarching alive and well by volunteering at one of our walks.
