Roadrunner Year Around Events:

Eisenhower Park

Eisenhower Park is located about 2 miles north of loop 1604 on Northwest Military Highway and was opened to the public in 1988 as a natural area. The park was previously part of the US Army training site at Camp Bullis. The park is named after President

Dwight D. Eisenhower who was originally from Texas and was an Army commander at Ft. Sam Houston. Since the 317 acres of the park are designated a natural area, there is no skate boarding, roller blading or bike riding on the trails which makes it more pleasant to enjoy the lovely hill country scenery.

The registration for this yre is the Drury Inn at 1604 and I-10. Directions to the walk start will be at the top of the written instructions. Other information regarding this walk can be found on the AVA web site or in the Starting Point. Out of a dozen yre's hosted by the Roadrunners in 2016 this was the most popular yre.

The 10km route will visit the River Walk, La Villita, the Alamo, El Mercado, Main Plaza. The 6km route includes Main Plaza, Aztec Theater, Texas Ranger Museum, Majestic Theater and El Mercado.

1:00 PM: Opening ceremony (includes a brief talk by San Antonio Missions National Historical Park Superintendent Mardi Arce and a showing of the short film "Gente de Razón," about the San Antonio Missions.)

SATURDAY, 25 February, 2017

The 42K marathon goes to the four UNESCO World Heritage designated Spanish Missions and Mission Reach, before returning. The 20km route goes only to Mission Concepción and Mission San José, before returning. The 10km route goes only to Mission Concepción and back. The 5km route explores the area south of the event hotel, including the historic King William area.
