No Signs on Poles

Have you ever wondered why volksmarch directional arrows cannot be placed on electric poles? For a long time I thought the city didn't want the neighborhoods looking trashy with posted signs everywhere. In the August 2017 Texas Co-Op Power magazine (received by GVEC

subscribers) there was a very informative article "Don't Post on Poles." Placing signs on these poles can cause safety issues.

Anything attached to a pole can create a hazard for the lineman who has to climb the pole. "Sharp objects like nails, tacks, staples... can puncture rubber gloves and other safety equipment, stripping away critical protection from high voltage electricity." "Anyone placing these items on poles comes dangerously close to energized lines with thousands of volts of energy running overhead." p.24 When was the last time you saw a lineman climb a pole? The 20th NEC: A great group of enthusiastic, optimistic, hardworking and dedicated folks.

Deputy RDs: The Deputy RDs attended; and are an impressive group of individuals who will be a huge asset to the NEC and AVA: America's Walking Club. Our own Deputy RD (Ruthi) will be working on a plan to promote our walks with the Winter Texans along the southern Texas coast. More details to follow.

AVA's Strategic Plan: We are working hard on implementing the Strategic Plan that was approved June 2016 in Fredericksburg. Several members of the new NEC participated in developing the plan, which is helpful.

2019 Albany Convention: Planning is on-going, and our senior leaders did an on-site visit last week. They met with the Mayor, the Chamber of Commerce and the Visitor's Bureau. The NEC will hold their June 2018 meeting in Albany, allowing them to check out walks and venues, and get an update on the Convention.




Special Group Walks:

Benefits of Walking

Many doctors and other health professionals cite moderate physical activity, including walking, as a "magic pill" for excellent health. It can maintain the body's systems in good condition and reduce the risk of chronic illness.

Good health is not the only benefit of walking. In fact, there is a broad range of individual and community benefits that accrue when people walk more often and when communities are designed to make walking safe, enjoyable, and convenient.

Safety Benefits: Walkable neighborhoods have much lower rates

of traffic fatalities – for both pedestrians and motorists – compared with automobile-oriented areas.

<u>Health Benefits:</u> Fewer than 50% of Americans meet the minimum guidelines for moderate physical activity – walking is the easiest and most affordable way to correct this problem.

Social Equity Benefits: Low-income families are more reliant on walking for essential journeys than the middle class, and yet low-cost housing is often located in the most car-dependent places.

Environmental Benefits:

Transportation is responsible for one third of all U.S. greenhouse gas emissions – converting short driving journeys to walking journeys is reducing this impact significantly.

Transportation Benefits: One quarter of all trips in the U.S. are 1 mile or less, and yet most of these trips are taken by car – increasing walking reduces traffic congestion and the cost of road maintenance.

Economic Benefits: The average household cost to own and operate one car in the U.S. is \$9,000 per year — walkable neighborhoods allow families to own fewer cars and save money.
