AVA "Checkpoint" info:

The AVA accounting department is receiving a large number of orders from individual members without the correct payment enclosed. This has caused a higher number of balances left unpaid each month. Many of these individuals are ignoring the statements because they feel the balance is too small for them to waste a stamp on, or they don't feel they should pay sales tax or shipping.

As a non-for-profit corporation, we must make every effort to collect unpaid balances despite the fact that the balance is small. Because of the high number of individual balances that have occurred that cannot be collected, the following action is being put into practice:

Any individual who does not pay their balance within 90 days will be placed on credit hold and they will not be allowed to purchase from AVA until the balance is paid, also, a memo will be sent to awards. Their books will not be processed until the delinquent balance is paid in full.

Please realize that every item ordered, even if only one book, has shipping attached (unless you have a free shipping card which is sent in with the order). The free shipping card is for one each oaf a distance and event book, not for multiple books. The shipping charge for any one book or state bar ordered alone is \$1.00. Volkssport Associate Members should remember to deduct their discount. Be sure to supply your membership number. This is not your Record of Achievement Number as shown on the cover of your Awards Passbook. Anyone living in Texas must also include sales tax at the rate of 8.25% times the discounted amount
