### March Meeting Speaker

Our speaker for the March meeting will be Dr. David P. Green who is the editor of two widely used orthopedic and hand surgery text books: Rockwood and Greens's Fractures and Green's *Operative Hand Surgery* which are both now in their 4th editions.

Dr. Green is a graduate of Pomona College, Baylor Medical School and the N.Y. Orthopedic Hospital (NYOH) residency program. He is currently Clinical Professor, Dept. of Orthopedics, U.T.H.S.C. at San Antonio and Director of the Hand Surgery Fellowship in San Antonio. In 1997, he was named Outstanding Alumnus of the N.Y.O.H. His passion is teaching residents and fellows and he takes great pride in the alumni of the Hand Surgery Fellowship in San Antonio, of which he was the founding director.

Dr. Green was a 1975 ABC Traveling Fellow of the American Orthopedic Assoc. and is past President of both the American Society for Surgery of The Hand and the American Foundation for Surgery of the hand. His lifelong interest in people and the "what ifs" of history led him on a quest tracking down the origins of many names of streets, parks, schools, businesses, buildings and other landmarks in San Antonio

and surrounding counties. The result is a book entitled Place Names of San Antonio, published in 2002.
