The following three new Special AVA Programs will begin January, 2006: Pony Express, River Walk America and Railroad Heritage.

Railroad Heritage starts January 1, 2006 and runs indefinitely. The cost is \$8. Criteria: a sanctioned AVA walk, bike or ski event if the event trail follows, at some point, a former rail bed. This includes rails-to-trail as well as abandoned railroad tracks that are now legally used for recreational purposes. This program does not encourage or endorse any activity that results in trespassing along active railroads or railroad properties. The event passes a railroad station, either formerly or currently used for passenger and/or freight service. Qualified walks will be listed on Railroad Heritage website. Each event may be included only once, even if the event passes by or over more than one railroad or railroad station. The program can be completed at six distinct levels. A participant may turn in his/her book with 5, 10, 15, 20 or 25 stamps. Each level will bring you higher in the railroad line: Enrollment entitles you to be a Hobo; 5 events Passenger; 10 events Brakeman; 15 Fireman; 20 Engineer; 25 Conductor (remember the conductor is actually the boss of the train and is considered more essential than the engineer).
