Highlights of National Executive Council – October 15, 2005 – San Antonio, TX

President's Report:

The IVV has accepted 6th Continent – Africa. The first walks are scheduled in October, 2005. Many countries are now establishing permanent trails i.e., Switzerland, Lichtenstein and Finland. Germany will have permanent trails in 2006.

South Tyrol will host the next IVV meeting. – June 2006

Odd Ivar Ruud was voted in again as President of IVV, but will not seek to serve more than the upcoming term. Lynn Clark is again a Vice President for this one time three-year term.

Through recommendation of President Lindberg, the following items were approved:

- -Historian position be converted to a committee,
- -David Toth was approved as chair of Historian Committee and,
- -Hans Dieter-Fuhr continues as AVA European liaison to the IVV.

Executive Director Report:

- -Partnership with Fuel Belt and GNC is going well.
- -Yamax inventory received at Headquarters. (Pedometers).
- -New Balance will not continue its sponsorship after December 31, 2005 (all event materials with New Balance can be used until supply is exhausted).
- -The NEC gave Jackie Wilson approval to seek bids for the re-design of the AVA web page.

2007 Convention

The Committee is raising funds to help defray costs. An anonymous donation of \$5,000 was received for the Angel Island event.

Special Events

Current Special Events are running smoothly and new Special Events are being considered. Looking for approval of three new Special Events at the next NEC meeting.

A formal procedure for Special Events will be prepared in accordance with recommendations of Auditors, to be submitted at the next NEC meeting.

Youth

A Girl Scout *Walk Together* brochure has been developed for clubs when talking with Girl Scout Councils.

The Anchorage Volkssport Club will partner with the Susitna Girl Scout Council to run a contest with Girl Scouts to create the final designs for the GS participation patch for *Walk Togethers* for the 2006-2007 school year.

Technology

The 2006 Starting Point has been completed.

Additional club web sites have been added to the server.

Looking to possibly update the Web page to support club Officer Updates. A new server is required at AVA HQ. Estimated cost would be \$7,000. Any donations earmarked for this updated equipment would be appreciated. Someone needed to maintain website. Committee recommends a technician be hired by HQ to maintain website.

Volunteers Needed!

From Curt Myron - The AVA needs volunteers to help get better publicity in America. Everyone wants better name recognition for our sport, but we have done little on a national basis to create it. AVA wants to change that for the benefit of all of us, but we need volunteers from each region to participate on national committees.

This year AVA combined the publicity, marketing, sponsorship and partnership efforts as subcommittees under one chair, me. I've written and attached a concept to show how the

committee would work, with listed responsibilities for each of the subcommittees. Joan Lampart, AVA vice-president, has volunteered to chair the Publicity subcommittee; T.I. Weintraub, Rocky Mountain Regional Director, will chair the Marketing subcommittee, and I will chair the sponsorship/partnership.

John Ferguson has nominated a volunteer for the marketing subcommittee and she has accepted the position. What we need from the Southwest Region is one more volunteer for the Publicity subcommittee, with experience in the following areas: Job experience in the media (radio, TV, magazines or newspapers); writing experience, particularly for new media, advertising or the internet; marketing and advertising experience; market analysts or specialists, or business/marketing consultants.

If you are interested in helping the sponsorship/partnership committee, I need a dedicated volunteer who can strategize and isn't shy about communicating with companies to present AVA's mission and seek sponsors. I don't envision a committee will require a lot of your time, and it won't involve any travel as we will meet via email. But, this position will require thought and frequent communication with other team members located across the U.S. as well as some writing.

We all want AVA to grow and succeed. And with the current national emphasis on weight reduction and physical fitness, we have a large audience that is willing to listen.
