IVV Dues

Annual dues were paid in full to the IVV. AVA is charged 13 Euros per club as of the end of each calendar year. At the end of 2007, AVA had 316 clubs. Total dues paid amounted to slightly over \$6,000.

Volunteer Positions Available

AVA has a need for volunteers for specific tasks. Many of these tasks are related to your own neighborhoods. The positions are described below. If you are interested, contact either Curt Myron at president@ava.org or Jacklyn Wilson at jackie@ava.org

Travel advice for foreign volkssporters. With the Euro stronger than the dollar, many more Europeans plan to visit the USA. AVA has a European liaison but he has not traveled in the United States nearly as much as many AVA volkssporters. Both AVA and our economy can benefit from foreign travelers. When we find a volunteer for this position, AVA will advertise our ability to assist travelers in the IVV World Report and on the IVVwebsite(www.ivv-web.org).

- AVA Clubs in Schools. Local volunteer needed to act as AVA point of contact with your local elementary, middle or high schools to promote AVA clubs in schools. Material for starting a club is already complete and HQ has resources to coach you in contacting your school. If you know a teacher or education administrator, why not spread AVA's program to just one school.
- Course College Level in Volkssporting. A few community colleges now have accredited physical education courses based upon volkssporting events. AVA needs volunteers who know college teachers or administrators and are willing to present AVA program materials to their local college. All the materials are provided by AVA; we just need you and your contacts. So far, there has been interest in this program from several states, including Washington, Oregon, Texas, Colorado, Georgia and Florida.
- AVA Clubs on Military Bases. With the decline of US troops stationed in Europe, AVA must increase its efforts with military units in the continental United States. Are you an employee at a military installation or retired military with ties to a particular base? AVA needs a volunteer at each base who is willing to promote AVA by presenting volkssporting material base/post recreation and welfare offices; perhaps assist in forming Volkssport clubs on military bases. AVA HQ provides all the materials, but we need someone for that important face-to-face contact.
- <u>Upgrades to AVA Website.</u> The AVA Website Committee, led by Steve Hughart, is actively planning a complete review and reformat of our AVA website. This effort applies to all AVA systems, including the finance system, membership data bases and AVA office systems. Regular updates and site maintenance will continue while we gather your opinions and suggestions as to

- what computer and website support you want from AVA. Comments individuals, from clubs and/or state organizations are needed. There is no limit on what you can suggest but we need your help to compile a 'to do' list. Once that list is completed, the committee will form an action plan, prioritize the tasks and gather volunteer resources to make it happen. Please send your comments via email cmmyron@earthlink.net and enter the words AVA SYSTEMS UPGRADE in the subject line so we can identify your comments quickly.
- Museum Volunteer. We need someone to continue where our previous volunteer left off. Awards have been sorted by year but they still need to be put in some logical display order. Things that can be grouped together to make a framed display need to be pulled. Many items just need a good cleaning.
