America's Gardens

Runs January 1, 2009 through 2011. Criteria: Participate in 20 different sanctioned events where the route actually utilizes the pathways of a named flower garden open to the public. Private gardens open to the public only on specific dates can count if the regular walk event is also scheduled on those same days. For seasonal and year-round events, the gardens must be open to the public on all applicable days to count. Arboretums, plantations, botanical gardens and parks containing named gardens may also be considered. Routes that include temporary display gardens set up for the occasion of a public flower festival count only during the actual days of the festival.
