### Tin Star Ranch Event

Come along and make a family outing by joining the Fredericksburg Walking Club, Volkssportsverein Fredericksburg, on Saturday June 13. Choose a 5K or 10K walk through The Tin Star Ranch and the beautiful Texas Hill Country. Also available is the Lady Bird Johnson Community Pool for a swim event. Founded in 1976 the Fredericksburg Walking Club is the first Volkssportsverein Club in the United States and in Texas.

Tin Star Ranch is a 370 acre ranch that is one of Fredericksburg's finest attractions. There are five 1800's style guesthouses and an old west town reflecting exact replicas of historic buildings from the frontier days. See Judge Roy Bean's Jersey Lily Saloon, the Alamo, and others. The back of each of these buildings is part of an official Single Action Shooting (SAS) range. The town is built on a hill with breathtaking views of the surrounding pastures and hillsides.

Both walks will begin at the Longhorn Saloon and take walkers through the street of Old Town past the Alamo and out into the beautiful Texas Hill Country on both paved and unpaved country roads. Walkers will see longhorn cattle, western artifacts and wagons of the old west. When you finish your walk purchase a hamburger lunch at the Longhorn Saloon and continue to enjoy your family outing looking around the old city and the grounds of The Tin Star Ranch.

This event is held regardless of weather conditions. Swim, walk, jog or run at your own pace. The swim event is 8:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m., finished by 1 p.m. The walk event is 8 a.m. - noon, finished by 3 p.m. Pets are welcome but must be kept on a leash and with the owner at all times.
