Another morning walk, mostly through the streets of downtown Atlanta. Lots of reminders of the '96 Olympics, especially around the Centennial Park area. The directions in that area were a bit confusing but we stumbled through.

We washed the sweat off and headed off to Columbia, S.C. We have a daughter there so we stayed a few days. She did the Columbia walk with us. That is a very nice walk. We left there and went to visit a son in northern New Jersey. We had intentions to do a New Jersey walk, but the rain there was heavy and continuous so we abandoned that idea. After a few days with them we headed home with a stop in Cincinnati to visit another son.
